## Recipes



### **Peanut Butter and Pumpkin “Biscotti” Dog Treats (“Biswoofti”)**

- 2 1/2 cups flour (whole wheat or regular)
- 2 eggs
- 3/4 cup pumpkin purée (canned or homemade)
- 3 tablespoons peanut butter
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon ground cinnamon

Place all the ingredients (except the peanut butter) in a bowl. Mix until well combined. Flatten dough with a roller (or empty glass bottle) into a large rectangle (the size of a cookie sheet). Spread peanut butter on flattened dough. Roll up the dough on itself as if to make a “roll cake”. Press down on the roll cake so that it is no more than ½ inch in thickness (height). Slice the roll crosswise into 1/2 inch slices. Place the slices cut side up back onto the baking sheet. Bake for 35 minutes in a preheated 350 degree F oven (175 degrees C).

### **Cheese and Beef “Quiches” Dog Biscuits (“Barkiches”)**

- 2 1/2 cups flour (whole wheat or regular)
- 2 eggs
- 1 1/2 teaspoons beef bouillon granules (1 ½ cubes)
- 1/2 cup hot water
- 1 1/2 cups shredded cheese (or left over bacon/meat or anything your pup enjoys).

Dissolve the bouillon granules in hot water in a large bowl. Add the eggs and flour. Mix until well combined. Add the shredded cheese. Knead dough until all the ingredients are well incorporated. Roll the dough into a long snake (about ½ inch to 1 inch in diameter). Cut the dough in ½ inch slices. Place the slices cut side up back onto the baking sheet. Bake for 40 minutes in a preheated 350 degree F oven (175 degrees C).
